Weeks 1–10 | All Subjects: Core (4) + Trade (1 of 6 shown) + Commercial Field (8) = 13 Subjects Total

About This Term: The Second Term of SS2 Commercial builds directly on the First Term and introduces new depth across every subject. English moves into reported speech, active/passive voice and formal letters; Economics moves from perfect competition into monopoly, monopolistic competition and oligopoly, then into industries, agriculture, national income and public finance; Commerce moves into co-operative societies, public enterprises, trade associations, industrial combinations and labour; Financial Accounting and Book-Keeping both progress – Financial Accounting into manufacturing and partnership accounts and incomplete records, Book-Keeping into simple trading, profit & loss, and balance sheet preparation; Business Studies covers business communication, meetings, customer service and starting a business; Marketing moves into warehousing and international marketing; Insurance covers life, fire, motor and marine insurance and claims procedure; and Store Management covers purchasing, materials handling and stock budgets. All 13 subjects (Core, one Trade, and the Commercial Field) are covered across Weeks 1–10. Week 7 is mid-term review/assessment. Week 11 = General Revision; Weeks 12–13 = Examinations.

Note on Trade Subjects (shaded green): Each SS2 student must offer ONE trade subject, continuing the trade chosen in SS1. All six trade subjects approved by NERDC are shown here for reference. Having moved into specialised, intermediate-level skills in the First Term, the Second Term deepens practical competence in each trade: Computer Hardware & GSM Repairs moves from mobile telecommunication theory into hands-on fault diagnosis and component-level repair (screens, batteries, charging ports, soldering); Livestock Farming moves into housing, rabbit and pig production, and farm record-keeping; Beauty & Cosmetology moves into skin analysis, facials, makeup application and salon hygiene; Horticulture & Crop Production moves into vegetable and fruit-tree production and landscaping; Solar Photovoltaic Installation & Maintenance moves from system components into actual installation, earthing, testing and troubleshooting; Fashion Design and Garment Making moves from pattern drafting into collars, sleeves, trousers, and full garment construction.
