About This Term: The Second Term of SS3 Commercial is the deep-content and WAEC/NECO mock term. English Language advances to narrative, expository, descriptive, and speech writing alongside comprehension, summary, oral consonant sounds, and a full mock paper. General Mathematics covers integration (definite integrals and area under a curve), probability, permutations and combinations, vectors, and matrices (operations, inverse, simultaneous equations by matrices, and transformations). Citizenship & Heritage Studies examines public administration, public service ethics, local government, fiscal federalism, Nigerian foreign policy, international organisations, and conflict resolution. Digital Technologies covers spreadsheet applications (Excel/Sheets), database applications (Access/MySQL), presentation technology, accounting software (QuickBooks/Sage), digital marketing tools, entrepreneurship and ICT, and data analytics. Economics advances through demand, supply, market equilibrium and price control, elasticity of demand, theory of production, cost theory, and revenue theory. Financial Accounting covers company final accounts (P&L and Balance Sheet), manufacturing accounts, departmental accounts, incomplete records, and the cashflow statement. Commerce treats home trade, wholesale trade and agents, foreign trade, customs and port administration, transportation, and business communication. Marketing covers market research, segmentation and positioning, sales management, advertising, PR and sales promotion, and distribution channel management. Government examines pressure groups, public opinion and mass media, citizenship, constitutionalism, human rights, electoral systems, and the interplay of military rule and democracy in Nigeria. Literature-in-English focuses on deep text study (prescribed novel, play, and poetry anthology), oral literature, critical essay writing skills, and integrated text revision. Religious Studies (CRS/IRS) and a Trade subject complete the programme. All subjects include a mid-term assessment in Week 7 and a full revision and mock paper in Weeks 9–10.

Note on Trade Subjects (shaded green): Each SS3 student offers ONE trade subject. In the Second Term of SS3, all five trade options reach advanced professional and entrepreneurial levels: Computer Hardware & GSM Repairs covers POS terminals, advanced CCTV/AI integration, hybrid solar/inverter systems, fibre optic installation, cybercrime investigation basics, and server administration; Fashion Design & Garment Making covers children's wear, men's formal shirts, African textile fashion, uniform production management, and fashion merchandising; Livestock Farming covers integrated farming systems, tilapia/rice-fish aquaculture, advanced snail farming, dairy cattle enterprise, livestock marketing, environmental management, and agribusiness finance; Beauty & Cosmetology covers trichology, advanced wig construction, electrotherapy, editorial/SFX make-up, body contouring, cosmetic chemistry, and spa treatment planning; Horticulture & Crop Production covers soil science, nursery management, advanced vegetable/fruit production, irrigation systems, organic horticulture, and export horticulture. All trade subjects include a mid-term practical assessment and culminate in a Second Term practical examination.

	Government	Citizenship – meaning and types (citizenship by birth, registration, naturalisation); rights and duties of citizens; loss of citizenship; dual citizenship; statelessness and international protection.
	Literature-in-English	Drama study – in-depth analysis of the prescribed SS3 play: plot construction, dramatic conflict, characters (protagonist, antagonist, foil), themes, stagecraft, language, and dramatic irony.
	Christian Religious Studies (CRS)	Integrity and honesty in the Bible – Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5:1–11); Joseph resisting Potiphar's wife (Genesis 39:1–23); the importance of integrity in Christian witness and nation-building.
